At the foot of mighty Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest and most famous mountain lies Amboseli Sopa Lodge - on the edge of Amboseli National Park - within 200 acres of private land, a stone's throw from the place which in the early 1930's, inspired Ernest Hemingway's unforgettable story "The Snows of Killmanjaro."

Home to the Masai tribe, the park is also host to over 400 species of breeding birds and teems with rare and wonderful wildlife. The rustic charm of the lodge lends itself not only to safari but also to those adventurers wishing to conquer the mountain's snow-capped peaks.

An idyllic venue for weddings, a wide variety of activities can be arranged in and around the lodge, as well as in the park.
